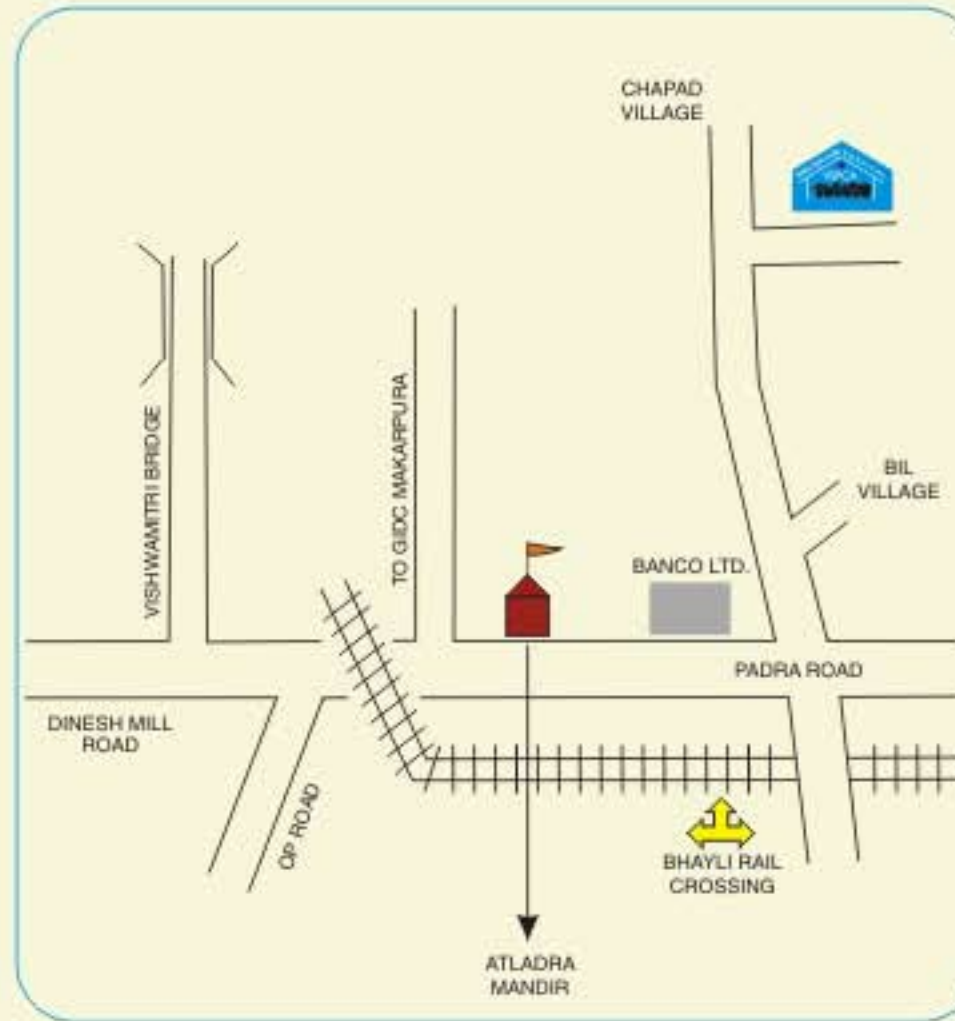

Our History

We are the oldest organisation in Vadodara working for the welfare of animals. We started our work in 1991 from the Zaverchand, Gaekwad Premises. In 1994 a modern hospital and shelter were established at Chapad Village on a 5 acre plot.



Our Mission

We rescue animals in need, treat injured animals and give a home to abandoned animals. We sterilise street dogs so that their number is reduced. Every day we strive to fulfil our commitment to animals.



Our Activities

We get a number of calls every day about animals in distress. Our two ambulances move around the city picking up these animals and bringing them to our hospital. Vadodara SPCA rescues and treats about 3000 sick and disabled animals every year.

One of the regular programmes that Vadodara SPCA undertakes is the sterilisation of stray dogs in which 5000 dogs are sterilised annually. Our shelter has a large number of cows, dogs, birds and other animals at any given point of time. There are two full time doctors and five assistants in the hospital. Ten more people are employed to look after the animal hospital. Dr. Ransingh S Purohit has performed unique treatments like saving dogs that have been covered with tar. He also is an expert in treating all types of tumours and performing amputations.

We now have a modern air-conditioned Operating Theatre for small animals. We are the first in Vadodara to have an Orthopaedic Unit and an X-ray facility.



Rescue Camps

We have a camp every year on the 14th and 15th of January during the kite-flying festival to treat birds that get entangled in the kite string. Sometimes the birds are so badly wounded that to save their wings or their life seems impossible but our veterinary surgeons do everything possible to make them whole again. If the birds are unable to fly they are kept in our aviaries so that they are protected all their lives.
